1. DESCRIPTION:

The United States Navy's Military Sealift Command (MSC) requires the following items for the USNS Comfort (T-AH 20) in accordance with the five-year requirement specified by MSC's selected records drawing (SRD) policy.

- Updated Power System Elementary Wiring Diagram
- Updated Lighting System One-line Diagram
- Updated Electrical Plant load Analysis (EPLA)
- Fault Current Analysis (FCA)
- Protective Devices Coordination Study (PDCS)

The Contractor shall create new versions of the Power System Elementary Wiring Diagram, Lighting System One-line Diagram, EPLA, FCA, and PDCS using information from existing drawings and analyses, and gathered during a Contractor ship check.

The purpose of this market survey is to identify companies capable of performing the updates to the required diagrams, analysis, and study. All Small Businesses are encouraged to respond. The Government will determine whether a set-aside acquisition in lieu of unrestricted competition is in the Government's best interest.

2. PLACE OF PERFORMANCE:

Work will be performed at the Contractor's facility and onboard the USNS Comfort (T-AH 20) in Norfolk, Virginia and/or Baltimore, Maryland.

3. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE / DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS:

The period of performance is expected to commence upon issuance of an order and end approximately ten months later.
